

Press Note

The Hon'ble Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee has reached North Bengal for visiting the flood and land-slide affected areas and monitoring the relief operations being undertaken there presently. Hon'ble CM will also be visiting the affected areas in Jalpaiguri and Darjeeling districts in the coming days and review the relief and restoration works there.

Today, besides holding the review meeting held at Hasimara with the Department HoDs, District Administration and Police personnel; Hon'ble Chief Minister also visited Suhasini tea garden and handed over relief material to the affected tea garden workers and their families.

Several officials who have rendered particularly noteworthy services during the hours of distress in the disaster hit districts were also recognised and awarded by the Hon'ble Chief Minister; 3 civil defence volunteers, one forest department official and 3 Disaster Management Department officials were amongst those who received the awards.

Hon'ble CM has also instructed all concerned to further intensify efforts to ensure return to normalcy for the hard hit and badly affected areas.
