- Amader Para Amader Samadhan (APAS) is yet another people-centric and welfare oriented, innovative effort of the Government of West Bengal to reach out and empower people through effective participation and engagement, to usher in sustainable, inclusive and locally appropriate development.
- The initiative seeks to institutionalize participatory governance and reimagine grassroots service
 delivery by inviting members of the community to APAS camps for deliberation, identification,
 and prioritization of schemes to be implemented for the resolution of small but crucial link
 infrastructure gaps/issues affecting their locality and daily lives.
- Rs Ten Lakhs is allocated to each booth and nearly Rs 8000 crore works will be undertaken
 across the state.
- APAS Camps have been scheduled from 2nd August to 3rd November 2025.
- More than 31,700 camps have been scheduled to be held up to 3rd November 2025, taking APAS closer to the people.
- Already as on today 28,299 Camps covering almost 90% of polling booths have been held, drawing more than 2.20 Crore visitors so far.
 - North 24 Parganas has held the highest number of camps (2,990) followed by South 24 Parganas (2,349) and Murshidabad (2,309).
 - The largest number of visitors have been recorded from Paschim Medinipur (28.9 lakhs) followed by South 24 Parganas (21.5 Lakhs) and Purba Bardhaman (20.08 Lakhs).
 - Paschim Medinipur also has the highest average number of visitors per camp (1,931) followed by Purba Bardhaman (1,304) and Malda (1,271).
- Schemes for roads, street lighting, drainage and water supply constitute more than 80% of the total works prioritized through discussions in the community meetings held during the APAS camps
- Districts have received more than 3.58 lakh schemes from the blocks / urban areas and approval for the implementation of 2.84 lakh schemes has already been given. Tender processes have already been initiated for 1.86 lakh schemes. Work orders have been issued for almost 10,000 schemes and around 100 schemes are already complete.
- With respect to various government services delivery under the Duare Sarkar initiative in the APAS camps, already more than 94.7 lakhs applications have been received of which approval for 77.4 lakhs (81.7%) has already been accorded and final services have been delivered for 56.66 lakhs.
- Some APAS Camps have been rescheduled in areas affected by floods and landslides in North Bengal districts and Special Out Reach Camps have been organized for relief assistance and re-issue of documents to the affected people.
